As we begin paddling along the Russian River estuary, your guide will talk about this unique area and its history. Enjoy your beautiful surroundings--sandy beaches and cliffs on one side, rolling hills, pastures, and forests on the other. Keep your eyes peeled for coastal birds, including herons & egrets, as well as fish in the water and deer in the meadows. The water is fairly calm with some current; perfect for both those who want to relax and those who want a challenge. Midday we serve our picnic lunch along one of the many small beaches at the water's edge. Next to the glistening water you will enjoy our lunch, and afterwards there will be plenty of time to take a dip in the cool water--the perfect way to refresh yourself in the warm afternoon sun. During the day we will make our way out towards Penny Island, hopefully catching a glimpse of the playful Harbor Seals and Elephant Seals that call the beach at Jenner their home. From a safe distance we watch them sun themselves and take dips in the cool water. Around 2pm we head back to the launch to take our kayaks out of the water, so there is plenty of time to take a drive along the coast or enjoy a leisurely drive through the redwoods on your way home.
